

The City of DeKalb is hosting an Open House Meeting concerning proposed improvements to Lucinda Avenue. This project seeks to reconstruct the intersection of Lucinda Avenue and Normal Street as a roundabout as well as resurface the remainder of Lucinda Avenue between Annie Glidden Road and Kishwaukee Drive. The meeting will be held on December 5th, 2023, from 3:00 pm to 5:00 pm at the DeKalb Police Station Training Room located at 700 W Lincoln Hwy, DeKalb, IL 60115. All persons interested in this project are invited to attend this meeting.

The objective of the meeting is to discuss the need for the improvement project, present the proposed project, and obtain public input. Project exhibits will be on display for review. The City of DeKalb and consultant representatives will be available to discuss the project and answer any questions.
